## Consideration of an appointment to the Valdosta-Lowndes County Development Authority.

Mayor Matheson stated that the Valdosta-Lowndes County Development Authority has a member, Aneesha Johnson, who resigned for personal reasons. Ms. Johnson, whose term is a joint appointment between the City of Valdosta and the Lowndes County Board of Commissioners, will expire on January 1, 2024. This appointment was advertised according to the Boards, Commissions, Authorities, and Advisory Committees Policy that was adopted by Mayor and Council. The applicants are John D. Crawford, Vice President for University Advancement (Valdosta State University) and Austin Stolpestad, Commodities Contract Manager (U.S. Air Force, Moody Air Force Base).

Mayor Matheson entertained nominations from Council for an appointment to the Valdosta-Lowndes County Development Authority.

Councilman Gibbs placed into consideration John Crawford. There being no other nominations, Mayor Matheson closed nominations.

Mayor Matheson stated that John Crawford would be appointed by acclamation to fill the unexpired term of Aneesha Johnson on the Valdosta-Lowndes County Development Authority.

## Consideration of an appointment to the Valdosta-Lowndes County Parks and Recreation Authority.

Mayor Matheson stated that the Valdosta-Lowndes County Parks and Recreation Authority has a member, Stan Rome, whose term will expire on June 30, 2022. Mr. Rome has expressed an interest in being reappointed. This appointment was advertised according to the Boards, Commissions, Authorities, and Advisory Committees Policy that was adopted by Mayor and Council. Stan Rome was the only applicant to apply.

Mayor Matheson stated that if Council had no objections, Stan Rome would be appointed by acclamation to serve a term of three years on the Valdosta-Lowndes County Co Parks and Recreation Authority. There were no objections from Council.
